

Letter from the President

Summer has arrived and the Chelmsford Business Association (CBA) is once again the lead sponsor of the Fourth of July Parade. This year's parade included over 80 separate floats, marching bands and vehicles of almost every description. The Town, our elected officials and everyone involved made for a great day. Yes it started rainy, but by 10AM the rain had let up and offered ideal weather for the parade. I can't say enough about the efforts put forth by the Parade Committee. They did an outstanding job putting together a great parade. Our fundraising efforts allowed us to expand our commitment to many great bands. The band I was happiest to see was our own Chelmsford High School Marching Band. The Band Director, the school and the band members themselves came together to make us proud. Plans are to make their appearance a yearly event. The banners in the Center of Town looked great. The response to our raffles was terrific, as always.

In other news, the realities of the April override failure have begun to take place. The closing of the Westland's School has been a challenge to implement. As the Town Manager and Board of Selectmen look ahead, the likelihood of further reductions is becoming apparent. As the Town looks for additional revenue streams, I strongly encourage them to continue the relationship they have forged with Tom Galligani, Chelmsford's Economic Development Manager. Both Tom and Evan Belansky (Chelmsford's Community Development Coordinator) hosted two Economic Development Seminars at the Senior Center on Groton Rd. These

seminars have laid the groundwork that will help decrease the vacancy rate on commercial and retail property in Chelmsford. This is a strong avenue to pursue. Homes, especially those with children, use more of the Town services than they support. Businesses, while paying the same tax rate as residential homes, use far less of the Town's services. Additionally, most of the Town services that businesses do use have costs attached (e.g. building permits, liquor licenses, dairy licenses, excise taxes, user fees, etc). To fill up existing, and develop new, commercial enterprises is the best way to gain on our budget deficit. One of the ideas floated at the seminar was to pursue wording in our bylaws that would encourage Bio Tech firms to consider relocating or developing new business in Chelmsford. Presently there is no restriction to Bio Tech firms locating in Chelmsford; but to encourage what will be a growing and dynamic field is just good planning.

Looking ahead, the CBA's Annual Golf Social is fast approaching; mark your calendars for Monday, September 15th, see page seven.

We will take our summer break with a healthy balance sheet, a growing membership and a great group of people looking to make Chelmsford a better place to live and work.





ARTICLE V

NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

Section 1: The Directors and Officers for the ensuing year commencing January 1st; shall be elected by the entire membership according to the rules specified in subparagraphs (a through f) of this section under the direction of the current Nominating Committee.

- (a) The election shall take place on a date to be determined by the Board of Directors in the month of November.
- (b) Nominations shall be made by a Nominating Committee designated by the President consisting of five (5) members, not more than three (3) of whom may be a current member of the Board of Directors.
- (c) The Nominating Committee shall place on the ballot sufficient names to fill all officer positions and sufficient to fill all open director positions. In addition, any member may be nominated by petition of ten (10) members and with his/her assent be placed upon the ballot by the Nominating Committee. Said petition must be submitted to the Association's Secretary not less than twenty-one (21) calendar days prior to election.

(d) A notice with the names of those nominated appearing thereon, in alphabetical order according to their surname, shall be mailed to all Association members in good standing not more than fifteen (15) days nor later than ten (10) days before the election. Those names receiving the highest number of votes at the annual meeting shall be declared elected. Election at the annual meeting may be in such manner as the Board of Directors dictates.

(e) In the case of a tie for any office, the one (1) to serve shall be determined by lot at the annual meeting by the President.

(f) Nominations received after the time designated in subsection (c) above shall be void.

Section 2: Within ten (10) days after the annual election, the Directors for the ensuing fiscal year shall meet and establish its committees for the ensuing year.

Section 3: Vacancies for unexpired terms on the Board of Directors may be filled by the membership for the unexpired term at the next meeting of the membership.
