


Rest in Peace Linda Harrington







Chelmsford's Proposed Outdoor-Lighting Bylaw

One of the many things I love about Chelmsford is the collective willingness to preserve and utilize the large tracts of open space that exist here. It was in this spirit that, back in 2000, Bob Morse and I authored a bylaw — approved unanimously at that year's Fall Town Meeting — to regulate outdoor lighting. It was one of the first such bylaws in the state, and it was pretty simple in concept: If you have an outdoor light above a certain brightness, it needs to be shielded so that all the light is directed below horizontal and/or doesn't shine onto neighboring properties.

Now fast-forward a quarter century. Today our night-time environment is illuminated everywhere by light-emitting diodes or LEDs. This amazing technology was just in its infancy in 2000, and our simple bylaw could not have foreseen how ubiquitous — and bright — LEDs have become.

There's a widespread perception that more light is better, that it's OK to flood our surroundings with lots of light so that we can all be safe and secure. But that's not what research shows. The biggest problem is glare from unshielded fixtures. Glare can be so bad that it prevents you from seeing your surroundings at night (think "super-bright car headlights"). This is especially true for our seniors, whose eyesight is especially challenged by strong glare.

With these considerations in mind, the Planning Board and I have put forward an update to the existing outdoor-lighting bylaw. This time, we're proposing a general bylaw to replace the existing zoning bylaw. The most important distinction is that, if it's enacted, existing noncompliant lighting will not be grandfathered. No doubt you've installed LEDs around your business and/or your home in the past few years. And if those fixtures aren't shielded (pointing straight down), they're likely in violation of the existing lighting bylaw. You don't need to be a lighting expert to see that many, many such lights have proliferated around town.

But the changeover to better lighting will not occur overnight, so to speak, and the proposed bylaw includes a 10-year "grace" period" to bring all lighting into compliance. I've been working with the CBA, as well as other stakeholders in town like the DPW and public-safety managers, to make this bylaw a step forward that everyone can support.

This proposed bylaw will be Article 29 at Spring Town Meeting. In the meantime, please feel free to contact the CBA's executive team — or me — with questions or concerns you might have. 





